4-H is a community of young people across America who are learning leadership, citizenship and life skills. 4-H is about having fun, learning, exploring and discovering. In 4-H, young people make new friends, develop new skills, become leaders and help shape their communities.

- After they select a project, 4-Hers work with a leader or parent to gain skills and knowledge in the subject matter area.
- Leaders work to train the individuals and teams to compete in the project subject matter area.
- Resources are available at the Leon County Extension Office as well as the State 4-H website.
- Clover Kids may only PARTICPATE in some county contests (They will receive a participation award).



The 4-H Emblem and Colors

The 4-H Club emblem is a four-leaf clover with the letter "H" on each leaf. The four "H's" stand for head, heart, hands and health. Leaves of the clover are green and the "H's" are white. The white is for purity. Green is nature's most common color and is symbolic of youth, life and growth.
