Divisions will include Photography, Sewing and Needle Art, Baked Goods, Food Preservation, Fresh Produce, Art (Painting, Drawing, Sculpture, Fiber/Clay), Creative Arts, Quilts \& Plants (Other than Produce). Numerous categories for each division will be offered. Listed below are the general rules. Category details will be forthcoming.

## General Rules:

1. Entries must be submitted Friday, June 30, 2023 from 10:00am to 1:00pm at the First United Methodist Church Centerville. Judging will take place beginning the afternoon of Friday, June 30, 2023. Judging is closed to the public.
2. Entries will be on display July 1st from 9:00 AM to (noon) 12:00 PM, FUMC. Entries must be picked up from (noon) 12:00-1:00 PM on July 1st.
3. The silent auction will begin when the display opens on July 1st at 9:00 AM and will close at (NOON) 12:00pm. Items bought may be picked up at noon and payment must be made at that time.
4. All items must be made within the past year (after July 4, 2022), with the exception of quilts, which may be made in the past 2 years.
5. All baked goods and fresh fruit and vegetables will be sold in a silent auction on July 1st. Proceeds will serve to fund the Home and Garden Fair.
6. Youth with youth entries sold in the silent auction will receive the proceeds from their project.
7. Adult entries will be $\$ 1.00$ per item entered. Youth $\$ .50$ per item entered.
8. Entries will receive quality awards - Blue, Red, or White awards. Class winners will be selected from blue ribbon winners. Division winners will be selected from class winners. Art entries may receive other awards as well.
9. Age categories will be as follows:

- Preschool- Ages 5 \& Under
- Junior- Ages 6-10
- Intermediate- Ages 11-13
- Senior- Ages 14-18
- Adult- Ages 19 and up
