1. Open to all youth who are otherwise eligible to participate in LCYLS.

i. Age Divisions:

- ii. Peewee (at least 5 years old & not in the 3rd Grade)
- iii. Junior (3rd-5th Grader)
- iv. Intermediate (6-8th Grader)
- v. Senior (9-12th Grader)

2. Entry Drop Off & Deadline:

- **Entry Deadline, Saturday, April 5, 2025 by 6:00pm** at Leon County Expo Center
- **Entry Fee is \$5/print**
- Drop Off Times:
 - March 31-April 4, 2025 from 8:00am-4:30pm at Leon County Extension Office (113 West Main St. Centerville, TX 75833 on 3rd Floor)
 - April 5, 2025 from 4:00-6:00pm at Leon County Expo Center (**Must be entered by 6:00pm**)

3. Photo Entry Requirements:

- Consist of 8X10 Prints, not matted or framed.
- Contestants may enter ONE print per category.
- Categories are:
 - Life on the Farm
 - Livestock
 - Farm Humor
 - Showtime

4. Judging:

- Photos will be judged using the Texas 4-H Photography Score Sheet
- Judges will be local/area photographers who have participated in Centerville Funtier Days and/or Jewett Fall Frolic photography contests

5. Awards & Display of Photos:

- Awards & Photos will be on display during LCYLS from Tuesday-Friday.
 - Results will be emailed to all contestants and will be posted on social media.
 - There will not be a formal photography awards ceremony.
- Awards & Photos may be picked up at the conclusion of LCYLS Sale on Friday Night or on Saturday during clean up or the following week at the Leon County Extension Office.
- Photography becomes the property of the Leon County Youth Livestock Show and may be used for future marketing and promotional purposes.
